WELLBEING KIS

Wellbeing - Effectively mobilise available resources to support students' wellbeing and mental health, especially the most vulnerable.

LEARNING TARGETS:

Attendance:

- Improve the proportion of students with less than 20 days absence from to 5% in 2021 to 80%

NAPLAN:

- Improve the per cent of Year 9 students achieving in the top two NAPLAN bands in Reading from 6% to 8%, Writing from 6% to 7% and Numeracy from 5% to 7%
- Improve the per cent of Year 9 students retained in the top two NAPLAN bands in Reading from 32% to 70%, Writing from 13% to 70%, Numeracy from 50% to 70%
- Improve the per cent of students meeting and above NAPLAN benchmark growth in Reading from 67% to 75%, Writing from 69% to 75% and Numeracy from 75% to 80%

ACER:

- At least 60% of students achieving scale score growth of 2.0.

Senior Secondary:

- Increase the VCE All Study Median score from 27.46 in 2021 to 29 by 2025
- The Senior Certificate completion rate to be greater than 95 per cent completion by 2025

WELLBEING TARGETS:

Attitudes to School Survey:

Improve the per cent of positive endorsement in the Attitudes of Students to School Survey in the measures:

- Differentiated learning challenge from 65 per cent in 2021 to 70 per cent by 2025
- High expectations for success from 77 per cent in 2021 to 90 per cent by 2025
- Student voice and agency from 60 per cent in 2021 to 75 per cent by 2025
- Stimulated learning from 62 per cent in 2021 to 75 per cent by 2025

ACER Social-Emotional Wellbeing Survey:

- To continue to improve student sense of wellbeing from years 7 to 12. This will be evidenced by achieving a mean SEW score at each year level that is within 15 points of the national mean for that year level.
