Hampton Park Secondary College offers an exciting Instrumental Music Program, which includes a variety of musical instruments to learn, specialising in rock, pop, and contemporary music.

The aim of our music program is to empower students by developing their love of music. Learning an instrument promotes exceptional teamwork and improves musical skills, as well as academic performance across different subjects. It has been proven that music gives a sense of achievement which in turn boosts confidence in all learning areas.

#### Instruments

Currently we offer instrumental music lessons in small group sessions for the following instruments: keyboard/piano, drums, acoustic/electric/bass guitar, vocals, and woodwind instruments such as clarinet, flute, or saxophone. Where possible, all students should have their own instrument to practice on at home (keyboard and woodwind instruments can be hired from the school and drummers only need sticks and a practice pad). Please contact us if you would like assistance with instrument purchase or hiring.

#### Lesson Information:

- Permission slips are required to be returned to the front office with payments before students can start their lessons
- The cost for the whole year is \$120
- Payment is non-refundable and can be made upfront in full or through a payment plan
- Lessons will be run in small groups
- Students will be advised of their lesson times early in the year and/or shortly after payment has been received
- Our program operates during school hours and students will come out of regular classes, alternated each week to attend instrumental lessons once a week
- Lessons run in both A5 (our music room) and the River Gum Performing Arts Centre (RPAC) located on our college campus
